Ticket Information:

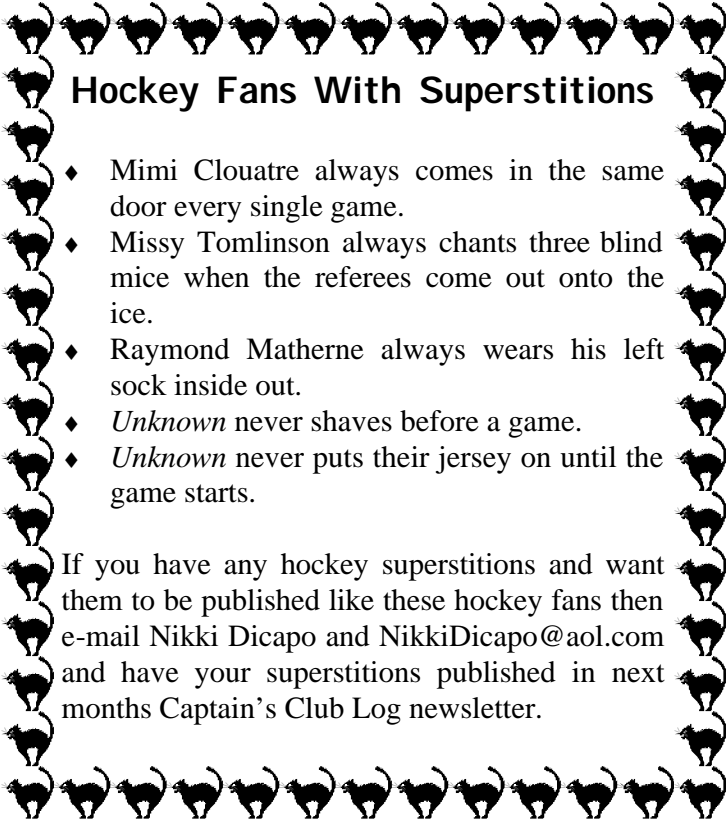
- Cost of tickets in sections 108 and 109 behind goal we shoot at twice is \$12.00

- The "host hotel" is the Beachside Resort (1-800-232-2416)
Rates are \$69.95 for a double and \$89.95 for a King with beach view.
** Upon speaking with someone in reservations, was told only availability for that time is the beachfront King.....did have ONE double available.
- Best Western (1-800-934-3301)
Rates are \$79.00 for inland rooms with free continental breakfast.
All rooms have the following amenities - refrigerator, microwave, and coffeemaker.

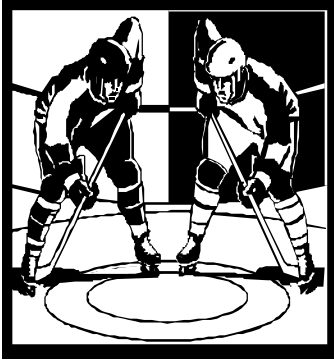
