"Scarlet Begonias' by the Grateful Dead."

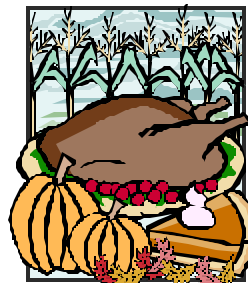
Do you have any pets?

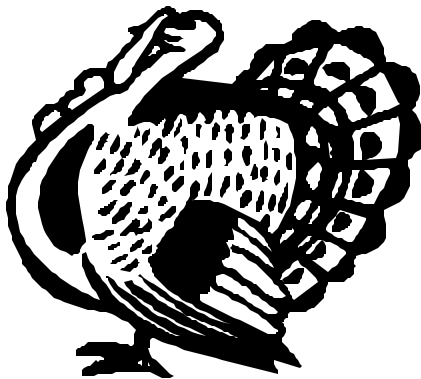

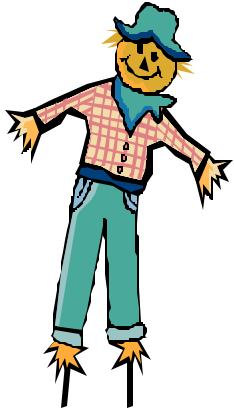

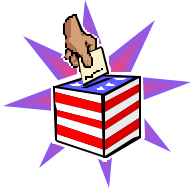

ADA WALK

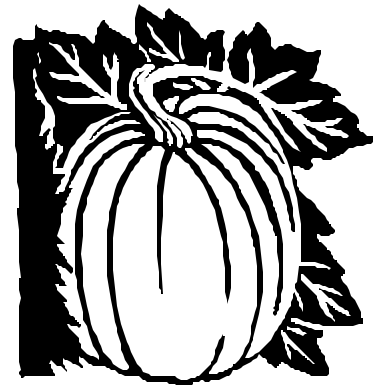

Activities Committee

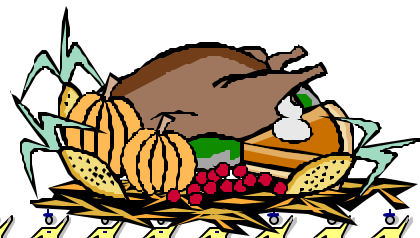
The Meet the Kingfish party was a success. There was about 130 members and players in attendance. The decorations and food were excellent.

Kingfish Hockey Etiquette

Below are some helpful ideas to pass on to the Kingfish fans around you. Hopefully this will help everyone have a very enjoyable experience at the Kingfish Hockey games.

- ◆ Arrive early to avoid the traffic and long lines.
- ◆ Stay seated during game play! If you have to get up, do it when there is a stoppage in play. Also don't return to your seat until play has stopped.
- ◆ Yelling obscenities at opposing players, referees, or fans from other teams is not appropriate! Remember this is a family event!
- ◆ Do not under any circumstances throw any objects on the ice. This will result in a penalty for our team and could result in someone getting injured.
- ◆ Do not leave the game early. This can be a distraction to our team and they will notice it. The game is not over until the final buzzer sounds and true Kingfish fans will wait till the end.
- ◆ Drink in moderation to avoid rude behavior and accidents to other hockey fans.

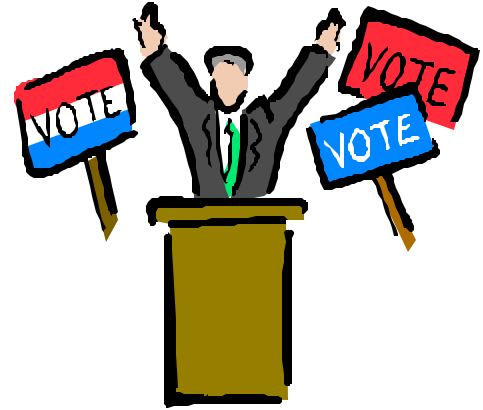
Thanks to Jeremy and Stan for taking their time to come and speak with us.

We will be collecting non-perishable food items.

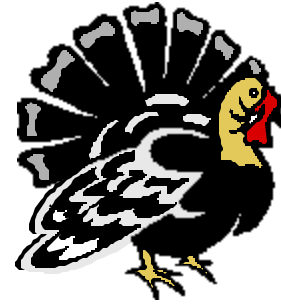

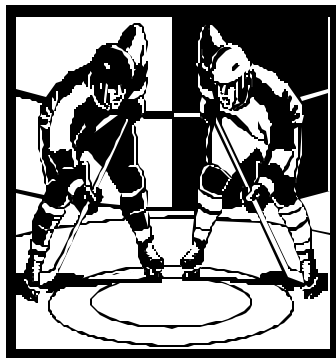
